MAJOR CONGESTION ON TETON CANYON AND DARBY CANYON TRAILS

The US Forest Service is requesting that residents and visitors avoid Teton Canyon and Darby Canyon trails tonight and throughout the eclipse tomorrow. It is highly congested and though it is still open to the public, it is very unlikely that people will be able to drive far enough in to park to hike to preferred areas. The US Forest Service suggests choosing eclipse locations along the valley floor that also offer great eclipse visibility rather than trying to access trails up high.
