- Resource managers use a variety of treatments to restore wildlife habitat. For example prescribed fire, manage wildfire for multiple objectives, and a range of mechanical fuels treatments.

- Why this treatment rather than the other treatment methods?

- Would you consider allowing access to the National Forest System lands over your land for fuel treatment projects?

- Would your recreational use be affected by this fuels treatment?

- Do you feel that your home or subdivision is at threat from wildland fire?

- If so, what subdivision or area of the south end of Teton Valley do you live?

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- Are you adjacent to Forest Service or BLM lands?

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- Do you have information about protecting your home from wildland fire?

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- Is there any issue or concern within the area that you would like to comment upon?

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- Is there anyone else in the area that you think we should talk to about these or other issues?
