

## CHAPTER 2

### TREE BOARD

#### SECTION:

2-2-1:           **PURPOSE:** It is the purpose of the ordinance to promote and protect the public health, safety, and general welfare by providing for the regulation of the planting, maintenance, and removal of trees, shrubs, and other plants within the City of Victor, Idaho.

2-2-2:           **AUTHORITY:** There is hereby created and established a City Tree Board for the City of Victor, Idaho, which shall consist of three members, that do not have to be residents of Victor, who shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council. Members of the board shall serve without compensation.

2-2-3:           **TERM OF OFFICE:**  
The term of the three persons to be appointed by the mayor shall be three years, except that the term of one of the members appointed to the first board shall be for only one year and the term of one members of the first board shall be for two years. In the event that a vacancy shall occur during the term of any member, his or her successor shall be appointed for the unexpired portion of the term.

2-2-3:           **PROTECTION FROM LIABILITY:** No individual, including council and commission members and the administrator or other city employees, who acts in good faith and without malice in the performance of duties, assigned by this ordinance, shall be held liable for errors or omissions in its administration. A suit brought against such an individual shall be defended by the city and any judgment resulting from such a suit shall be the liability of the city. (Ord. 94-1101,11-1-1994)
