STRAY ANIMALS

4-3-1: Impoundment

4-3-1: **IMPOUNDMENT:**

- A. Running at Large: It shall be unlawful for any person owning or having in his care any cattle, horses, mules, colts, hogs, goats or any other domestic animals that may be considered a nuisance by reason of it running at large within the corporate limits of the city.
- B. Stray Animals Defined: Any or all of the animals enumerated in subsection A of this section found loose in any street, alley, public place or on the private property of anyone other than the owner thereof shall be considered strays.
- C. Poundkeeper to Take Charge: The poundkeeper shall take charge immediately of any estrays.
- D. Fees: Any person redeeming estrays shall pay per head for each animal not immediately removed from the estray pound. Such fee shall be set in accordance to the Victor Fee and Fines Schedule which may be amended from time to time by resolution of the Victor city council (Ord. 17, 2-2-1915; amd. 11-7-1956)
