

CHAPTER 1

PARKING REGULATIONS

5-1-1: **PARKING ZONES ESTABLISHED; DESIGNATED:**

- A. Zone Establishment: The city council has heretofore established, and shall hereafter establish, from time to time as it deems proper and necessary for the control of traffic, parking zones upon the streets of the city. The establishment of, and all changes in, such zones shall be only as duly ordered by the city council and entered in the official minutes of its meetings.
- B. Designation: The city council is authorized and directed to designate all parking and loading zones by causing appropriate parking signs to be installed upon the streets clearly informing the public of the location of the parking zones and the parking time allowed therein. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

- 5-1-2: **PARKING LANES:** The Victor street superintendent is hereby authorized to cause lane markings to be painted or placed upon the curbs and/or streets designated vehicle parking spaces. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle across any such lane markings or to park any vehicle in a position such that is not entirely within the lane markings, except when the lane markings are not visible due to snow on the street. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-3: **DIAGONAL/REVERSE DIAGONAL PARKING ZONES:**

A. Specific Parking Zones:

Parking in the manner prescribed by this ordinance shall be in all zones within the City as designated by the City. (amd. Ord. 09-0722, 07-22-09, amd. Ord. 14-1112-2, 11-12-2014)

B. Manner of Parking:

1. Angle Parking: The driver of any vehicle parking in the diagonal parking zone shall turn his vehicle to the right and toward the right hand curb so that the parked vehicle makes an angle of forty-five degrees (45°) with the curb. (amd. Ord. 09-0722, 07-22-09)

2. Reverse Angle Parking: The driver of any vehicle parking in the reverse diagonal parking zone shall first turn on the vehicle's right blinker while approaching the parking stall, second stop the vehicle past the parking stall while leaving sufficient maneuver room, and third back the vehicle toward the right hand curb so that the parked vehicle makes an angle of forty five degrees (45°) with the curb. (amd. Ord. 09-0722, 07-22-09)

5-1-4: **NO PARKING ZONES:** No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer in any of the following places:

- A. Painted Curbs: In front of a zone where the curb is marked with red or yellow paint.
- B. Driveways: In front of a public or private driveway.
- C. Fire Hydrants: Within fifteen feet (15') of a fire hydrant.
- D. Intersections: Within an intersection. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-5: **UNLAWFUL PARKING:** It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle, or, having parked the same, to suffer it to remain parked in violation of the regulations on any duly installed parking sign. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-6: **PARKING IN ALLEYS:** It is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle in any alley or alley entrance except for the actual time required for loading or unloading such vehicles. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-7: **SNOW REMOVAL¹:**

1. See chapter 2 of this title.

- A. The city shall remove snow from public streets. The city shall not be required to remove snow from public alleys or private property.
- B. It is unlawful for any person to hinder or interfere with any person engaged in removing snow for the city.
- C. It is unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle or leave any other obstruction adjacent to or on a public street in such a manner as to interfere with snow removal by the city. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-8: **IMPROPERLY PARKED VEHICLES:** The Teton county sheriff's department is authorized to have removed from the streets and impounded any vehicle or other obstruction parked in violation of the provisions of this chapter. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982; amd. 1996 Code)

5-1-9: **ABANDONED VEHICLES; IMPOUNDMENT:**

- A. Abandoned Vehicles: Whenever any vehicle shall be left unattended for more than twenty four (24) hours on any portion of a city street and is impeding traffic, the Teton County sheriff's department may provide for the removal of such vehicle to the nearest garage or other place of safe storage. Vehicles left unattended on street rights of way may be removed after five (5) days upon the passage of a Victor city council resolution requesting the removal.
- B. Impounded Vehicles; Costs:
 - 1. The owner of any vehicle which has been impounded under the provisions of this chapter shall pay a fee in accordance to the Victor Fee and Fines Schedule which may be amended from time to time by resolution of the Victor city council plus the cost of removing and towing of the vehicle.
 - 2. If the impounded vehicle is not claimed within ten (10) days after it has been impounded as provided in this section, the Teton County sheriff's department shall proceed as provided in Idaho Code section 49-592 for the sale or junking of abandoned vehicles. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982; amd. 1996 Code)

5-1-10: **SIGNS ON PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY:** It is unlawful for any person to place or maintain any permanent sign, billboard or advertisement on any public right of way in the city. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-11: **ENFORCEMENT:** It shall be the duty of any police officer, observing a violation of the provisions of this chapter to leave at or upon such vehicle a notice that it has been illegally parked. The notice shall bear the date and hour of leaving the same at or upon the vehicle, shall state the nature of the

parking violation observed, and shall instruct the owner or operator of such vehicle to report or make payment to the Teton County sheriff's department or Teton County magistrate's court within five (5) days with regard to such violation. When the violation is "overtime parking", a separate notice for each hour, or fraction thereof, that the vehicle remains in violation shall be issued. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)

5-1-12: FINES; PENALTIES:

- A. Fines: Any person violating any duly posted parking regulation shall be subject to a civil fine. The fines shall be assessed in accordance with the City of Victor Fee and Fine Schedule that is approved by resolution of the Victor City Council, which may be amended from time to time by resolution of the Victor city council. Any owner or operator receiving a notice or citation for a parking violation shall within ten (10) days of the day of the citation or the date of any decision on appeal that may be made, pay such fine to the City Clerk. Failure of the owner or operator to report and/or make payment as herein provided, shall render such owner or operator subject to citation for a misdemeanor which shall bear a fine that is in accordance with the Victor Fees and Fines Schedule and/or thirty (30) days' imprisonment in jail or both.(Ord. 14-0827-1, 8-27-2014)
- B. Disbursement of Funds: All monies collected by the Teton County sheriff's department or the magistrate's court of Teton County, Idaho, for violations of this chapter shall be paid to the city. (Ord. 1-82, 9-1-1982, eff. 10-1-1982)
